- ✓ Another advantage is that the lever design enables doors to be opened from a latched position even when your hands are full, so you can depress the lever with your elbow.

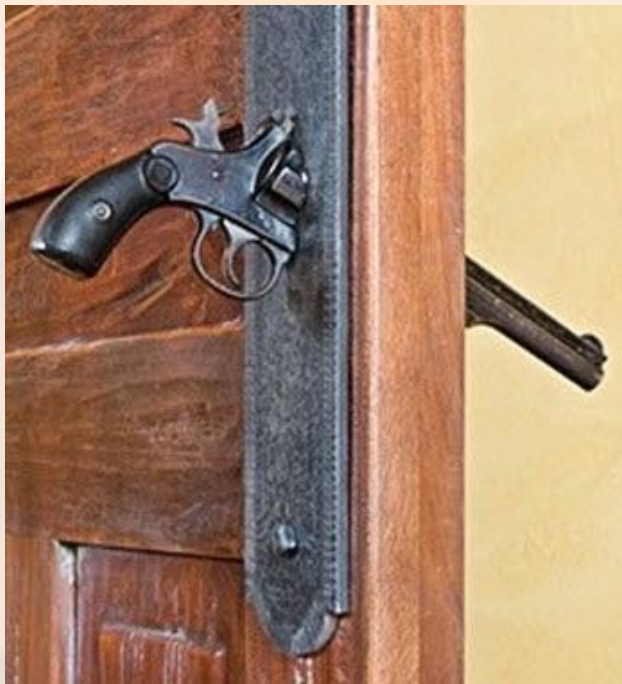
